SEACOR Island Lines to Provide Shipping Services for 2019 Crossing For A Cure *– Sponsorship to Include Shipping of OC6s, Dory Boats, Supplies and More to Bimini –*

LAKE WORTH, Fla., March 18, 2019 – SEACOR Island Lines (“SIL”), a wholly owned subsidiary of SEACOR Holdings Inc. (NYSE:CKH), is the most recent company to demonstrate its support of Piper’s Angels Foundation and the annual Crossing For A Cure endurance paddle event. The Fort Lauderdale, Fla.-based company will serve as the event’s official shipping and logistics partner to transport boards, boats, and race materials to the Hilton at Resorts World in Bimini, Bahamas – the headquarters for the 2019 event.

“We are one of the main carriers for products and commodities to Bimini,” said SIL CEO Michael LaFleur. “This event positively impacts the island – shops, hotels, restaurants and more – while also benefiting Piper’s Angels and Crossing For A Cure. SIL’s relationship with Piper’s Angels began last year, when SIL helped transport a six-person outrigger canoe (OC6) and dory boat to Bimini. This year, they will ship OC6s, dory boats, paddleboards, supplies and equipment to the starting point of the event. After learning more about the cause last year, the company wanted to become more involved and provide an even greater service this year.

“As a business, we have strong ties to Bimini and the businesses that operate in and around the area,” said SIL Regional Business Development Director Matthew Grauer. “This is a very worthy nonprofit organization and event. We’re excited to see this partnership come to fruition and watch the event grow year over year.”

Piper’s Angels Foundation is a non-profit organization focused on ocean-based activities for cystic fibrosis patients due to the proven health benefits of salt water. Its Crossing For A Cure charity event is a 75-mile endurance paddle challenge from Bimini, Bahamas to Florida’s Lake Worth Beach, which last year featured 100 paddlers and raised more than \$280,000 for cystic fibrosis patients and their families. This year’s event will take place on Saturday, June 15, with

Piper's Angels striving for a \$1 million fundraising goal between sponsorships and paddler fundraising.
